For example, a grant can be used to meet household expenses such as a mortgage or car payment, property taxes, a child's college tuition, transportation costs, medical bills, housing during treatment and more. Grants are made available every year to approved applicants. The process is completely confidential.

To date, the Foundation has raised over one million dollars and has offered financial assistance to more than 300 individuals throughout North America.
